What is a Sudden Cardiac Arrest?

- The heart suddenly stops pumping blood through the body and the person becomes unconscious.
- The person collapses, is not breathing, and does not have a pulse.






- A heart attack is when an area of the heart has lost blood flow and oxygen because of a blockage
- The person has a pulse, is breathing, and is conscious

Signs of a Cardiac Arrest

The person suddenly collapses without warning

The person may be making strange noises like grunting,

gurgling, or snoring



Sudden Cardiac Arrest can happen to anyone, anytime, anywhere!

400,000 people in the U.S. will die this year because they suffered a cardiac arrest outside of a hospital.

They don't all have to die!
