WARNING! Xylazine: A Drug That Naloxone Can't Combat

The Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) and Maryland Department of Health continue to warn of Xylazine, also known as "Tranq," a veterinary medication being mixed with fentanyl, cocaine, or heroine.

The side effects are serious, and since Xylazine is not an opioid, naloxone cannot reverse the effects. Read more


