If your student is **slightly older/younger**, please register and we will look at the registration. **We encourage siblings/friends to enroll together.**

WHEN?	Monday through Thursday for 2 weeks: July 17, 18, 19, 20, 24, 25, 26, and 27 from 10:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.
WHERE?	Life Skills sessions are currently being held online. The links will be provided prior to each class. Please ensure that you have downloaded Zoom prior to our sessions beginning.
HOW?	Students need a personal device equipped with a webcam and high-speed internet access. Students will connect with their teacher and other students using FREE Zoom conferencing software which will be downloaded to their device prior to class.

Changes to Maryland's Cannabis Laws Coming Soon



Starting July 1, 2023:

- Legal for 21+ only, doesn't apply to underage users
- Increased allowable possession
- Civil fines instead of criminal penalties
- No changes for medical cannabis users
- Adults 21+ can grow 2 plants at home, out of public view
- No cannabis in public places or vehicles
- Remains illegal under federal law

Men's Health Month




