to remain calm and verify that it's a scam? Would your children or grandchildren know it's not you giving them instructions if they heard your voice?

For many years, HC DrugFree has been urging all families to have secret safe words or phrases for children/teens to use when they need help fast or if they want to get away from potentially dangerous situations.
