During the spring and summer, HC DrugFree provided Life Skills classes to help middle and high school students build real-world skills. Students practiced healthy decision-making, refusal strategies, and communication techniques—all while learning how substances, especially opioids and other highrisk drugs, affect developing brains.

 - 1,359.5 lbs. of meds
- Fall 2025:
 - 1,125 lbs. of meds

Teen Advisory Council
